Sessions are offered seven days per week, each focusing on improving quality of life, conversation, and social connection. Virtual Connections is not speech therapy.

What does a Virtual Connections facilitator do?

Virtual Connections facilitators host the sessions via Zoom. Facilitating VC sessions is very flexible – dates, times, session topics, and structure are all up to you!

How often do facilitators volunteer?

Host as often as you are able! Facilitators can host sessions on a weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly basis. We appreciate any sessions you can provide.
