This role will join a small engineering team with 5 members that include a couple of senior software engineers, SDET and QA and work closely with our product manager in enhancing our product offerings.

The ideal candidate would be experienced in building and deploying applications for the Android platform. We are looking for a team player who is passionate about code quality and hungry to learn other technologies and development stacks as needed by the team.
